Quick Facts

A look at our fight against hunger in Westchester.

We work with nearly 300 community partners and programs to distribute around 1.8 million lbs. of food per month, or 1.5 million meals.

Feeding Westchester provides food to children, families, seniors and veterans facing hunger.

A \$1 donation to Feeding Westchester can provide 3 meals to a person facing hunger.

Feeding Westchester is the largest hunger-relief organization in Westchester County.

Over 200,000 (1 in 5) residents are at-risk for food insecurity in Westchester County.

Nearly 40% of all the food we distribute is fresh produce.

Feeding Westchester is the county's leading nonprofit hunger-relief organization at the heart of a network of nearly 300 community partners and programs. With a mission to nourish their neighbors in the fight against hunger, the organization sources and distributes good, nutritious food and other resources throughout every community in Westchester County. Last year, Feeding Westchester delivered 22 million pounds of food or 18.4 million meals through soup kitchens, food pantries, schools, shelters, residential programs, and mobile distributions. The nonprofit is committed to creating a community where all people have access to the food they need today, and the fundamental resources to build a better tomorrow.
